# 2/4 Port USB KVM Switch Operation Instructions

### **Before You Start**

# How to Connect

Note: The USB KVM Switch does not require any drivers or software.

- 1. Turn off both computers and their peripherals, and disconnect all power cords.
- 2. Connect the shared keyboard, monitor, mouse, microphone (optional) and speaker (optional) to the KVM Switch's console port.
- 3. Use the provided KVM and audio cables to connect your PC to your KVM switch.
- 4. Turn ON the first computer and wait until startup completes.
- 5. Press the face panel button on the KVM Switch to select the second computer (Optional).
- 6. Turn ON the second computer and wait until startup completes. Your installation is now complete.

### Switching Operation Instructions

Manual( push button): Simply press the appropriate port selection switch on the front panel. After you press the switch, the select LED lighting indicate that the port is current selected.

# Troubleshooting

- Q1: Where is the power supply? I did not find one in the box.
  - A1: The USB KVM switch does not require a power supply. It draws power from your computer's USB connection. As long as your KVM switch is connected to the USB port, it will receive the necessary power to function.

Q2: Can I connect and disconnect the USB cables while the computers are

turned on?

A2: Yes, you can connect or disconnect the USB cables while the computers are turned on because the USB interface is Hot-Pluggable.

Q3: Will the KVM switch remember the keyboard settings between computers?

A3: Yes the KVM switch will remember the keyboard settings when switching between your computers.

(i.e.: Caps Lock, Num Lock, etc.)

Q4: How do I switch from one computer to another with the KVM switch? A4: Push Buttons.

Q5: I have the KVM switch connected properly, but my keyboard and mouse don't work.

A5: First, make sure your USB port is working properly by testing it with your other USB devices. Second, once you confirm that the USB port is functional, please reboot your computers, and try to use the KVM switch again.

If the above steps still have problems, try to down load the USB driver as below link http://pan.baidu.com/s/1bYRchK and install it and then try it again.
